

Donor Bill of Rights and Privacy Policy

Irvine donors have these rights:

- 1. To be informed of the organization's mission, and of the way the organization intends to use donated resources.
- 2. To be assured of the organization's capacity to use donations effectively, and for the purposes for which they were intended by the donor.
- 3. To be informed of the identity of those serving on the organization's governing board, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
- 4. To be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers, employees of the organization, or hired solicitors.
- 5. To have access to the organization's recent financial statements.
- 6. To feel free to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful, and forthright answers.
- 7. To be assured that information about their donations is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.
- 8. To expect that all relationships with individuals representing organizations known to Irvine of interest to the donor will be professional in nature.
- 9. To receive appropriate acknowledgment and recognition.
- 10. To know that Irvine will not share, trade, or sell a donor's personal information with anyone else, nor send donor mailings on behalf of other organizations.
- 11. To opt out of receiving any future communications from Irvine.
