



Donor Bill of Rights and Privacy Policy

Irvine donors have these rights:

1. To be informed of the organization's mission, and of the way the organization intends to use donated resources.
2. To be assured of the organization's capacity to use donations effectively, and for the purposes for which they were intended by the donor.
3. To be informed of the identity of those serving on the organization's governing board, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
4. To be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers, employees of the organization, or hired solicitors.
5. To have access to the organization's recent financial statements.
6. To feel free to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful, and forthright answers.
7. To be assured that information about their donations is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.
8. To expect that all relationships with individuals representing organizations known to Irvine of interest to the donor will be professional in nature.
9. To receive appropriate acknowledgment and recognition.
10. To know that Irvine will not share, trade, or sell a donor's personal information with anyone else, nor send donor mailings on behalf of other organizations.
11. To opt out of receiving any future communications from Irvine.
